Heart for Cambodia held a leader training in November, which was attended by our 19 church leaders and 48 other Christian pastors and leaders from the region. The three-day seminar included instruction in conducting baptisms, communion, weddings and funerals. Church leaders are being equipped to lead their congregations with more and more independence, an important step in their growth as leaders. Leaders who completed the 3 days will receive a certificate.

Also included in the seminar was training and practice in evangelism. The sessions culminated in the trainees going out on foot in four teams, to the north, south, east and west, to share the gospel with whoever they encountered. The four teams, Holy, Grace, Peace and Joy met with people in homes. They shared the good news of Jesus, invited them to church, and prayed with them. Some received Bibles and others were promised a Bible if they will come to church.

It's time for the corn harvest and some of the teams found people working in the fields. One team helped load the corn and then shared their message of God's love. Another team, after not finding

anyone home, searched for the family and found them in the field, where they visited. Another man they met on the road told the team that he passes the O-Khmom church regularly but has never visited.

Team members were energized by their opportunity to meet, share and pray with people.
