Ministry in Wartime

The congregations in Cambodia remain strong through challenging times in their region. Last summer, while Chiv and Emara In were ministering in Cambodia, Thailand attacked the northern border of the country due to a long-standing border dispute. Many people were evacuated from their homes and placed in camps. Rather than heading home, Chiv and some of his church leaders gathered food and supplies and went into the camps to bring the love of Jesus to the evacuees through tangible relief.

While a cease-fire is currently in place, two of Heart for Cambodia's churches and their members are still in displaced persons camps, as the danger is still high near the border. The churches at Knarosey and Pouthivong are unable to meet in their buildings, and most members of these two congregations are living in the camps. They continue to hold worship, however, and the other church leaders have been able to take relief supplies into the camps.



Chiv and leaders from Knarosey and O-Khmom visited a camp for evacuees in July, bringing the love and hope of Jesus as well as food and supplies.

With members of the two churches still living in the camps, there is still opportunity for ministry. In December, Heart for Cambodia sent funds to help with food, gas, and travel expenses during this evacuation. Some of the church leaders have since visited the camps with food and blankets.

Chiv and Emara plan to return to Cambodia soon to encourage the people and bring a message of comfort and hope. Please pray for God's leading as to the timing of their next trip.

Please pray for the safety of the people and that they will soon be able to return to their homes. Pray that God's word and his comfort will reach even more people during this difficult time through those who already know Jesus. Pray for an end to the fighting.
